



Hoodland Women's Club Scholarship

Background: The Hoodland Women's Club has established a scholarship program for students who graduate from an accredited school and live within the boundaries of the Hoodland Community.

Amount: Four scholarships for \$3,000 each

Eligibility and Criteria for Selection:

- Preference – a preference will be given to students who live within the boundaries of the Hoodland Community (Alder Creek to Government Camp). Consideration will be given to highly qualified applicants with strong ties to the Hoodland Community.
- Age Limit – for students who have graduated from high school
- Time Limit – The scholarship must be used within 24-months from the time awarded.
- Qualified Schools – Sandy High School, other accredited charter schools and home schoolers.

Application Process – To be eligible to be considered to receive a scholarship, the student must:

- Complete an application (get from the SHS Counseling Center)
- Include a resume
- Provide a copy of their official transcript
- Write an essay:
 - o Showing financial need
 - o Showing service to the community
 - o Indicating educational goals and identifying the college, university, vocational school, technical school or beauty school they plan to attend
- Have a letter and/or letters of recommendation

Due Date: All of the above must be delivered to the SHS Counseling Center by **April 3, 2026 by 3:00 p.m.**
